THE INHERITOR *aka L'héritier* (1973-France/Italy) 112m *** D: Philippe Labro. Jean-Paul Belmondo, Jean Rochefort, Carla Gravina, Maureen Kerwin, Charles Denner. Bart Cordell (Belmondo) is a US-educated (Harvard, no less) son of a media tycoon in this fabulously slick thriller. Bart believes there was foul play involved in daddy's death, and the closer he gets to unmasking the enemy, the more his own life is imperiled. This film is steeped in the best of 1970s glamor: Belmondo in his prime, fashions with sleek fluid silhouettes, huge sunglasses and lots of glossy surfaces. Enjoy this stylish gem. For ages 16 and older.

DISCOVERY AT DAWN *aka La scoperta dell'alba* (2012-Italy) 86m *** D: Susanna Nicchiarelli (COSMONAUTA). Margherita Buy, Susanna Nicchiarelli, Sergio Rubini. Caterina (Buy) and her sister Barbara's (Nicchiarelli) family has been broken since the loss of their father Lucio, a professor at the University of Rome. In 1981, Lucio disappeared after his colleague Mario was killed on campus by the Red Brigade. Thirty years after her father's disappearance, at the family's beach house, Caterina discovers that she can speak to her 12-year-old self through an old rotary dial telephone. Can she change the course of her family's history? Nominated for 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: PUBLISH OR BE DAMNED (2024-New Zealand) 97m ***½ D: Awanui Simich-Pene. Neill Rea, Cristina Serban Ionda, Fern Sutherland, Cathy Downes, Holly Shervey, Rima Te Wiata. While on a writing retreat, brilliantly eccentric coroner Gina (Ionda) reports to detective Mike Shepherd (Rea) that she found the retreat's mentor, Dame Audrey McKinnon (Downes), floating face-down under a waterfall. While wondering if Gina supplied her own dead body, Mike and his team discover that Dame Audrey had ruffled quite a few feathers in this very entertaining murder mystery. For ages 14 and older.

WHAT'S FOR DINNER, MOM? *aka Mama, gohan mada?* (2016-Japan) 117m *** D: Mitsuhiro Shiraha. Haruka Kinami, Michiko Kawai, Izumi Fujimoto, Masahiro Kōmoto. In this mouthwatering drama, sisters Tae (Kinami) and Yo (Fujimoto) return to their family home after their mother Kazue's (Kawai) death. While there, Tae discovers a box containing her mother's cooking notes. Kazue, though Japanese, was an expert cook of Taiwanese classics such as soup dumplings, joong rice bundles, turnip cake, and pig's feet. Through Kazue's recipes, the sisters learn about their mother's life in Taiwan. Adapted from Tae Hitoto's memoir. For ages 12 and older.

THE IRON CLAW (2023-UK/US) 132m *** ½ D: Sean Durkin (MARTHA MARCY MAY MARLENE). Zac Efron, Jeremy Allen White, HARRY DICKINSON, Holt McCallany, Lily James, Maura Tierney. This riveting biopic chronicles the tragic history of the premier family of pro wrestling, the Von Erichs. The founding patriarch, Fritz Von Erich (McCallany), is famous for his "iron claw", a technique he passes to his four sons. Embittered and resentful, Fritz puts his sons through years of brutal training to win the championship title that's eluded him. Oldest son Kevin (Efron) shoulders the burden of protecting his brothers in this brilliantly acted story. Winner of 3 awards. Rated R.

SOLITUDE *aka Einvera* (2023-Iceland/Slovakia) 74m *** ½ D: Ninna Pálmadóttir (OBLIVION). Þröstur Leó Gunnarsson, Hermann Samuelsson. In this touching tale set in Iceland, old farmer Gunnar (Gunnarsson) is forced to move to the city when his farm is expropriated by the government. Missing his beloved farm, its beautiful mountain landscape and especially his horse Godi, Gunnar is at loose ends until he befriends Ari (Samuelsson), the sweet freckle-faced neighborhood paperboy. Slowly adapting to the ways of the city, Gunnar finds that even though there's no going back to the old ways, life can be good. Winner of 3 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE LONG EXCUSE *aka Nagai iwake* (2016-Japan) 124m *** ½ D: Miwa Nishikawa (DEAR DOCTOR). Masahiro Motoki, Pistol Takehara, Eri Fukatsu, Keiko Horiuchi. Adapted from her own novel, writer-director Miwa Nishikawa's **THE LONG EXCUSE** witnesses the redemption of a heartless cad. Successful novelist Sachio Kinugasa (Motoki) is in bed with another woman when his wife Natsuko (Fukatsu) dies in a bus accident. Natsuko had gone on a trip with her friend Yuki (Horiuchi), who also perished. Sachio finds himself looking after Yuki's grieving husband (Takehara) and children, who teach him what it means to be human in this thoughtful drama. Winner of 3 awards. For ages 15 and older.

DEATH AT THE RESERVOIR *aka Der Tote im See* (2018-Austria) 91m *** D: Nikolaus Leytner. Maria Hofstätter, Josef Hader, Miriam Fussenegger, Erni Mangold, Fritz Karl. Veteran cop Grete (Hofstätter) is having a lousy day. She's had to put her beloved cat Gandhi to sleep, and now she has to drag rookie Lisa (Fussenegger) with her to investigate a body found in the reservoir. When she finds her old flame, former cop Sepp (Hader), is implicated in the murder, Grete is torn as to how to pursue justice in this clever police tale set in a small Austrian town where everyone knows everyone. For ages 12 and older.

THE REFORMER ZWINGLI: A LIFE'S PORTRAIT (2019-Switzerland/Germany) 124m *** D: Stefan Haupt. Maximilian Simonischek, Sarah Sophia Meyer. In this immersive historical biopic set in 16th century Zurich, pious young widow Anna (Meyer) lives in fear of the Catholic church and concern for her three children. When 35-year-old priest Ulrich Zwingli (Simonischek) arrives with radical new ideas to reform the church (reading the scripture in German!) her life is changed. But Zwingli's reforms alarm conservative clerics, and soon dangerous armed conflict is on the horizon. This chronicle of Switzerland's influential Protestant reformer won 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: CASUALTIES OF WAR (2007-UK) 93m **** D: Tristram Powell. Michael Kitchen, Honesuckle Weeks, Stanley Townsend, Kevin Doyle, Kate Fleetwood, Joshua Lewis. MARCH 1943: The usually punctual DCS Foyle (Kitchen) is tied up at home with caring for his troubled goddaughter Lydia (Fleetwood) and her shellshocked young son James (Lewis). There are worrisome cases of sabotage in the area, and a gambling addict (Doyle) is found dead outside of a military research facility in this eventful episode. For ages 14 and older.

CONCLAVE (2024-UK/US) 120m *** ½ D: Edward Berger (ALL QUIET ON THE WESTERN FRONT). Ralph Fiennes, Lucian Msamati, Stanley Tucci, John Lithgow, Sergio Castellitto, Isabella Rossellini. Upon the sudden death of the pope, Cardinal Lawrence (Fiennes), dean of the college of cardinals, has the weighty responsibility of conducting a conclave, the highly secretive, ritualistic assembly of cardinals to elect a new pope. The majesty and mystery of the Catholic church is a backdrop to the political machinations of those who vie to lead it in this masterfully acted, intelligent thriller. Winner of 33 awards. Rated PG.

PAYROLL *aka I Promised to Pay* (1961-UK) 106m *** ½ D: Sidney Hayers. Michael Craig, Françoise Prévost, Billie Whitelaw, William Lucas, Tom Bell (*Prime Suspect*). In this pacy heist thriller set in Newcastle, crooks led by handsome rogue Johnny (Craig) plan to rob a factory's payroll. Johnny puts pressure on factory employee Dennis (Lucas) for inside information, setting off an unexpected chain of events. Françoise Prévost is especially memorable as Dennis's restless French wife in this snazzy noir. Co-scripted by long-time Hawaii resident Derek Bickerton from his novel. For ages 12 and older.

GET UP! *aka Geroppa!* (2003-Japan) 113m *** D: Kazuyuki Izutsu. Toshiyuki Nishida (GHOST OF A CHANCE), Takako Tokiwa, Taro Yamamoto, Ittoku Kishibe, Willie Raynor. Yakuza boss Daisuke (Nishida) is enjoying his last few days of freedom before his prison sentence in this wildly entertaining crime comedy. His second-in-command Kaneyama (Kishibe) decides to help Daisuke fulfill his bucket list: find Kaori (Tokiwa), Daisuke's long-lost daughter, and meet soul legend James Brown. To do this, a little bit of kidnapping might be involved... Winner of 6 awards. For ages 15 and older.

WHITE BIRD (2023-US) 121m *** ½ D: Marc Forster (THE KITE RUNNER). Helen Mirren, Ariella Glaser, Orlando Schwerdt, Bryce Gheisar (WONDER), Jem Matthews. In this lovely teen romance loosely based on the 2017 film **WONDER**, Julian (Gheisar) is struggling at a new school after he's been expelled for bullying another student. His artist grandmother (Mirren) tells him of her childhood, surviving Nazi-occupied France during WWII. Her tale, though set in a grim and violent place, is punctuated by moments of uplifting beauty. The Chicago Sun-Times praises the film's "artistry and the fine acting and the timeless messaging". PG-13.

LEGEND OF THE EIGHT SAMURAI *aka Satomi hakken-den* (1983-Japan) 136m *** D: Kinji Fukasaku (THE SHOGUN'S SAMURAI). Hiroko Yakushimaru, Hiroyuki Sanada, Sonny Chiba, Mari Natsuki, Yūki Meguro. In this totally bonkers samurai fantasy, the Satomi clan has been cursed for 100 years by the Motofuji clan—whose evil has transformed its members into demons. Led by chief demoneess Tamazusa (Natsuki), the Motofujis pursue the last surviving Satomi—Princess Shizu (Yakushimaru). Luckily, ancient scrolls prescribe a method to lift the curse—and it will take eight magical dog warriors to conquer the demons! Nominated for 4 awards. For ages 15 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: A NEST OF VIPERS *aka Un covito di vipere* (2017-Italy) 120m ***½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Valentina Lodovini, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Alessandro Haber, Sonia Bergamasco. When detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) investigates the death of a wealthy man found shot in his home, it emerges that the deceased was lethally poisoned before he was shot. Overkill? Or were there two people trying to kill him? The more Montalbano and his team delve into the victim's dark and twisted past, the harder it is to find the killer(s). The truth emerges from an unexpected source in this whodunit. For ages 14 and older.

HOW TO DESCRIBE A CLOUD (2013-Netherlands) 75m *** D: David Verbeek. Lu Huang, Yi-ching Lu, Pong Fong Wu. "The greatest distance is between two minds." This is what a biologist friend (Wu) tells former student Liling (Huang) when she talks to him about her mother. Taipei-based musician Liling travels home to a rural fishing village to help care for her mother (Yi-ching Lu) who has gone blind and increasingly speaks of gaining mystical powers. Liling feels compelled to help her mother through science, but the more time she spends with her mother, the more she's drawn to the unexplained. This innovative and visually striking film won 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.
