CRIME ON THE HILL (1933-UK) 64m *** D: Bernard Vorhaus. Nigel Playfair, Lewis Casson, Sally Blane, Anthony Bushell, Phyllis Dare. When the squire of a tidy English village dies, leaving his estate to his American ward Sylvia (Blane), no one is surprised. He was old, his heart was failing. But upon his death the troubles start: attractive middle-aged woman Claire (Dare) presents proof that she had secretly married the squire, disinheriting Sylvia. This generates rumors in the village so fierce that the squire's body is re-examined, revealing he had been murdered! This clever, surprisingly cinematic whodunit is a fine example of the genre. For ages 10 and older.

THRILLER: A COFFIN FOR THE BRIDE (1974-UK) 65m **** D: John Sichel. Michael Jayston, Helen Mirren, Michael Gwynn, Richard Coleman, Margaret Courtenay. Fitness fanatic Mark (Jayston) is making a tidy income from marrying wealthy older women and murdering them on the honeymoon. When he meets theatrical set designer Stella (Mirren) he's so smitten, he's willing to give up his life of crime... but then he meets a perfect target for one last job. This terrific little thriller is a showcase for young Helen Mirren's (Prime Suspect) talent. For ages 10 and older.

STATION aka Eki (1981-Japan) 132m *** ½ D: Yasuo Furuhata. Ken Takakura (DEAREST), Chieko Baishô, Ayumi Ishida, The Japanese icon of masculine stoicism, Ken Takakura stars in this picturesquely melancholic cop drama. Police officer and Olympic sharpshooter Eiji Mikami (Takakura) abandons his wife (Ishida) when he discovers she's been unfaithful. When his fellow cop/friend/coach is shot by an escaping criminal, Mikami feels cast adrift from all he's loved, and engrosses himself in catching the cop killer. This classic won 14 awards. Ages 12 and older.

THE WIDOWER (2014-UK) 136m *** ½ D: Paul Whittington. Reece Shearsmith, Sheridan Smith, Kate Fleetwood, James Laurenson, Archie Panjabi, John Hannah. This chilling true story chronicles the seemingly ordinary life of a serial embezzler and murderer. Malcolm Webster (Shearsmith) works as a nurse, and to all the world seems like a loving husband to his wife Claire (Smith) - until she dies in an automobile fire. This highly unsettling tale about a man who charms his way into the fortunes of women features a great performance by Shearsmith who manages to find a human soul within a monster. Winner of 1 award. For ages 14 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: PLAN OF ATTACK (2008-UK) 93m **** D: Tristram Powell. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Anthony Howell, Martin Hutson, Malcolm Sinclair. April 1944: The Allies have stepped up their bombing campaign, causing officer Henry (Hutson) to have grave moral misgivings about his job choosing German targets, especially as the Catholic priest he admires, Father Keppler (Sinclair), is German. When Henry is found dead hanging from a tree, Sgt. Milner (Howell) is stuck working the case with an uninspired new DCS, as Foyle (Kitchen) has retired. A twist of fate changes everything in this thought-provoking episode. For ages 14 and older.

A TIME TO LOVE AND A TIME TO DIE (1958-US) 127m *** ½ D: Douglas Sirk (IMITATION OF LIFE). John Gavin, Liselotte Pulver, Jock Mahoney, Keenan Wynn, Erich Maria Remarque (author of All Quiet on the Western Front and the novel for this film), Klaus Kinski. In 1944, on the Russian front, German soldier Ernst Graeber (Gavin) is granted a furlough. Back in Germany he finds his hometown bombed, and his parents nowhere to be seen. While searching for his family, Ernst runs into childhood friend Elizabeth (Pulver), whose father has been imprisoned for his political views. Among the ruins of their town, under constant threat of air raids, the two create their own paradise of love in this bittersweet romance shot in Germany. Winner of 1 award.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: LOVE YOU TO DEATH (2024-New Zealand) 93m **** ½ D: Katie Wolfe. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Cristina Serban Ionda, Ingrid Park, Sam Bunkall, Gareth Reeves. When coming out of anesthesia, flighty Jools Fahey (Park) gazes deeply into the eyes of dentist Sonny Lyman (Reeves) and falls obsessively in love in this episode. Not only does Jools' affliction appall her realtor husband Charles (Bunkall), it makes her the prime suspect for the murder of Sonny's wife, found dead in a fancy property Charles is trying to sell. For ages 14 and older.

ASPHALT (1929-Germany) 90m *** ½ D: Joe May. Gustav Frölich, Betty Amann, Albert Steinrück, Else Heller. In bustling Berlin, young traffic cop Albert (Frölich) lives an upstanding life with his loving parents (Steinrück and Heller). When Albert arrests elegant and seductive Else (Amann) for shoplifting in a jewelry store he faces the most difficult moral challenge of his young life in this splendid Weimar Era Straßenfilm "street film". A precursor to film noir, this silent film's fluid and expressive camera work is a revelation. Winner of a 1931 Kinema Junpo Award. For ages 12 and older.

LOVE STRIKES! aka Moteki (2011-Japan) 118m ***
D: Hitoshi Ône. Mirai Moriyama, Masami Nagasawa,
Kumiko Asô, Riisa Naka, Yôko Maki, Lily Franky.
Lonely dweebish 31-year-old Yukiyo (Moriyama) takes
a job at webzine Natalie and finds himself in contact
with four beautiful women: magazine editor Miyuki
(Nagasawa), office lady Rumiko (Asô), bar hostess
Ai (Naka) and work colleague Motoko (Maki). After
years of ridicule, Yukiyo finally has a chance of being
a ladies' man! Or not? This hilarious comedy won 2
awards. For ages 15 and older.

THE DEAD DON'T HURT (2023-Canada/Mexico/UK/US) 130m *** D: Viggo Mortensen. Viggo Mortensen (CAPTAIN FANTASTIC), Vicky Krieps (PHANTOM THREAD), Solly McLeod, Garrett Dillahunt, Danny Huston. Newly arrived on the US western frontier, Quebecoise Vivienne (Krieps) and Dane Holger (Mortensen) meet and fall in love in San Francisco. They travel to the quiet settlement of Elk Flats, Nevada to build a life together, but life on the frontier in the 1860s offers no luxuries such as law, order or civility. This historically accurate love story won Best Feature at the Almeria Western Film Festival. Rated R.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: AS PER PROCE-DURE aka Come voleva la prassi (2017-Italy) 113m ***½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Nuccio Vassallo, Isabell Sollman, Sonia Bergamasco. A naked and badly injured young woman manages to drive to Vigàta and dies in a condominium courtyard where no one claims to know her. Meanwhile, Montalbano (Zingaretti) meets an elderly judge named Attard (Vassallo) who takes a daily walk near Montalbano's home. This somber and thoughtful episode is leavened by a humorous encounter between Montalbano's girlfriend Livia (Bergamasco) and his daredevil gal pal Ingrid (Sollman). For ages 14 and older.

MISS FISHER'S MURDER MYSTERIES: Episodes 1 & 2 (2012-Australia) 112m *** ½ D: Tony Tilse, Kate Dennis. Essie Davis (THE BABADOOK), Nathan Page, Miranda Otto (THE LORD OF THE RINGS), Ashleigh Cummings, Jacek Koman. In this delightful mystery series set in 1920s Melbourne, pistol-packing flapper Phryne Fisher (Davis) comes home from her travels to keep an eye on her sister's murderer, who will soon be released from prison. Meanwhile, her friend Lydia's (Otto) husband is found dead in his bathroom. Phryne sets out to solve the mystery, much to the annoyance of local detective Jack Robinson (Page). For ages 15 and older.

BAANTJER: THE BEGINNING aka Baantjer het begin (2019-Netherlands) 111m *** D: Arne Toonen. Waldemar Torenstra (BRIDE FLIGHT), Tygo Gernandt, Lisa Smit, Peter Bolhuis. Clean-cut, earnest Jurre de Cock (Torenstra), from the fishing village of Urk, arrives in the big bad city of 1980s Amsterdam (a bit like 1980s NYC) to be a cop. He makes the rookie mistake of fishing a body out of a canal, starting a major conspiracy case just before the coronation of Princess Beatrix. This is the origin story of the Netherlands' favorite TV detective based on the novels by Appie Baantjer. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 15 and older.

CONCLAVE (2024-UK/US) 120m *** ½ D: Edward Berger (ALL QUIET ON THE WESTERN FRONT). Ralph Fiennes, Lucian Msamati, Stanley Tucci, John Lithgow, Isabella Rossellini. Upon the sudden death of the pope, Cardinal Lawrence (Fiennes) has the weighty responsibility of conducting a conclave, the highly secretive, ritualistic assembly of cardinals to elect a new pope. The majesty and mystery of the Catholic church is a backdrop to the political machinations of those who vie to lead it in this masterfully acted, intelligent thriller. Winner of 56 awards and nominated for 8 Oscars including Best Picture, Best Actor (Fiennes), Best Supporting Actress (Rossellini), Best Original Score and Best Adapted Screenplay. Rated PG.

GREYHOUND (2020-US/Canada/China) 91m ***½
D: Aaron Schneider (GET LOW). Tom Hanks,
Elisabeth Shue, Stephen Graham, Rob Morgan. In
this gripping adaptation of C.S. Forester's WWII
novel The Good Shepherd, Tom Hanks stars as Ernest
Krause, first-time captain of a Fletcher-class destroyer
assigned, with three other vessels, to protect a convoy
carrying troops and supplies across the North Atlantic
to England. During the treacherous three-day crossing
the convoy comes under relentless attack by German
submarines while out of range of surveillance aircraft.
Winner of 1 award. Rated PG-13.

DEATH DUEL ON DREAM CHASER HILL aka Inochi sasage sôrô: Yumeoizaka no kettô (1996-Japan) 89m *** D: Yuji Murakami. Ken Ogata, Tadanobu Asano, Yôko Minamino, Takako Fuji. Banished and forced to live a life of poverty after slaying his clan's corrupt chamberlain, Iori Tsukamoto (Ogata) makes a heart-breaking sacrifice to give his young daughter O-Kumi a good future. After many years on the road, Tsukamoto, now a fearsome sword-for-hire known as Unokichi the Reaper, visits his grown daughter (Minamino) at his home province. This tale written by master storyteller Shuhei Fujisawa is not to be missed. For ages 15 and older.

TREASURE (2024-Germany/France/Poland/Belgium/Hungary/US) 111m *** D: Julia von Heinz. Lena Dunham, Stephen Fry, Zbigniew Zamachowski, Iwona Bielska, Wenanty Nosul. In this touching tale set in 1990, New York-based journalist Ruth (Dunham) sets off on a budget journey to Poland to discover her family's past. Knowing her Auschwitz survivor dad Edek (Fry) would find the trip painful, she has mixed feelings when he decides to accompany her. He is as funny and spontaneous as she is serious and humorless, and he ends up derailing her carefully planned trip—much to her benefit. Nominated for 1 award. Rated R.

HIBI aka Days of Fire (2005-Japan) 114m *** ½ D: Banmei Takahashi. Yûko Tanaka (DEAREST), Shunsuke Kubozuka, Ittoku Kishibe, Chizuru Ikewaki. Single mom Kiyoko Koyama (Tanaka) is a determined woman. In 1970s sexist Japan, in the even more sexist pottery village of Shigaraki, she has her mind set on being the only female master of an "Anagama" tunnel kiln. Her goal: the elusive, spectacular natural ash glaze called shizen-yu. Just as she starts to see promising results, her family is dealt a life-threatening challenge in this powerful true story. Winner of 6 awards. For ages 12 and older.
