CLOUDS OF SILS MARIA (2014-France/Germany/Switzerland) 124m *** ½ D: Olivier Assayas (SUMMER HOURS). Juliette Binoche, Kristen Stewart, Chloë Grace Moretz, Lars Eidinger. Celebrated French actress Maria Enders (Binoche) is invited to star in the 20th anniversary revival of *Maloja Snake*. The play launched her career at age 18 playing the role of young Sigrid but she's now being asked to play the other lead character, Helena, a woman in her 40s. With the exasperated help of her hip young assistant Val (Stewart), Maria prepares for a role as an older woman...both on stage and in life. Winner of 18 awards. Rated R.

FOYLE'S WAR: BROKEN SOULS (2008-UK) 92m **** D: Simon Langton. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Joseph Mawle, Natasha Little, Jonathan Forbes, Nicholas Woodeson, Phyllida Law. October 1944: After 5 years on the battlefield, British soldier Fred Dawson (Mawle) comes home to his wife Rose (Little) and their young son Daniel. But the sight that greets him isn't what he expects: he sees a German soldier (Forbes) playing merrily with Daniel with Rose smiling at his side. When the German youth is later found dead, DCS Foyle (Kitchen) has a complex case to untangle in this intriguing episode. For ages 14 and older.

NOSFERATU *Extended Version* (2024-US/UK/Hungary) 136m *** ½ D: Robert Eggers (THE LIGHTHOUSE). Lily-Rose Depp, Nicholas Hoult, Bill Skarsgård, Willem Dafoe. Set in 1838 Germany, this atmospheric re-imagining of F.W. Murnau's classic vampire film finds sensitive young Ellen (Depp) flinging open her window to invoke a supernatural presence. The dark spirit reaches across centuries and great distance to possess her. Ellen's naïve young realtor husband Thomas (Hoult) is summoned deep into the Carpathian mountains to sell a German property to a wealthy client: Count Orlok (Skarsgård), who seeks to become the couple's very creepy neighbor. Nominated for 4 Oscars, all involving style, this film has already garnered 27 awards. Rated R.

MISS FISHER'S MURDER MYSTERIES: Episodes 1 & 2 (2012-Australia) 112m *** ½ D: Tony Tilse, Kate Dennis. Essie Davis (THE BABADOOK), Nathan Page, Miranda Otto (THE LORD OF THE RINGS), Ashleigh Cummings, Jake Koman. In this delightful mystery series set in 1920s Melbourne, pistol-packing flapper Phryne Fisher (Davis) comes home from her travels to keep an eye on her sister's murderer, who will soon be released from prison. Meanwhile, her friend Lydia's (Otto) husband is found dead in his bathroom. Phryne sets out to solve the mystery, much to the annoyance of local detective Jack Robinson (Page). For ages 15 and older.

MISS FISHER'S MURDER MYSTERIES Episodes 3 & 4 (2012-Australia) 100m *** ½ D: Kate Dennis, Tony Tilse. Essie Davis, Nathan Page, Ashleigh Cummings, Toby Schmitz, Ruby Rees. Private eye Phryne Fisher's (Davis) night out in Melbourne's hottest nightclub is ruined with a sudden death on the dance floor. Even worse, a man of Phryne's past, Charles (Schmitz) may be the culprit. Later, while investigating the disappearance of a young girl, Miss Fisher is embroiled in the plot by Latvian revolutionaries in this eventful set of episodes. For ages 15 and older.

WELCOME BACK, MR. MCDONALD *aka Rajio no jikan* (1997-Japan) 103m *** ½ D: Kôki Mitani. Toshiaki Karasawa, Kyôka Suzuki, Shunji Fujimura, Keiko Toda, Ken Watanabe. Mitani's hilarious screwball farce concerns a live Tokyo radio drama written by a meek housewife (Suzuki). After a successful rehearsal, the prima donna lead actress (Toda) demands that her character's name be changed to Mary Jane and her nationality from Japanese to American. This sets off a hysterically funny series of events that will take all the spontaneity and ingenuity of the radio station's staff to complete the broadcast. Winner of 17 awards. For ages 10 and older.

THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: THREE GOLD LEAVES OF JESUS (2024-New Zealand) 96m *** D: Jacqueline Nairn. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Cristina Serban Ionda, Cameron Rhodes, Nick Dunbar. In this funny and irreverent episode, Dr. Roger Plummer (Rhodes) interrupts his guilty pleasure of Morris dancing to go to the aid of a seriously injured man crawling out of the bushes—a man in a loincloth wearing a crown of thorns who has holes in the palms of his hands. For ages 14 and older.

DEAD TIRED *aka Grosse fatigue* (1994-France) 84m *** D: Michel Blanc (SUMMER THINGS). Michel Blanc, Carole Bouquet, Josiane Balasko, Philippe Noiret. In this ferocious send-up of French cinema, popular French comedian Michel Blanc (MON-SIEUR HIRE) starts getting accused of things he'd never imagine doing: a cabbie says he's stiffed him of a fare; his favorite nightclub kicks him out for insufferable behavior. What's going on? With a cast full of French celebrities playing themselves, this comedy won 2 awards at Cannes. For ages 15 and older.

AE FOND KISS (2004-UK/Italy/Germany/Spain/Belgium) 104m *** D: Ken Loach (THE WIND THAT SHAKES THE BARLEY). Atta Yaqub, Eva Birthistle, Shabana Akhtar Bakhsh. Glasgow DJ Casim (Yaqub) dreams of opening his own club, but for his Muslim parents' benefit, acts the role of dutiful son with an accountant's degree, blandly accepting an arranged marriage. His fiery sister Tahara (Bakhsh) is another story, and when she incites a near-riot at her school with her views, Casim comes to rescue her. There he locks eyes with beautiful Roisin (Birthistle), a young Irish Catholic music teacher. Their love affair scandalizes Casim's family, but somehow, optimism and humanism keep love's flame burning in this winner of 8 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE MAGIC HOUR (2008-Japan) 136m *** D: Kôki Mitani (ALL ABOUT OUR HOUSE). Kôichi Satô, Satoshi Tsumabuki, Eri Fukatsu, Haruka Ayase, Toshiyuki Nishida (SUITE DREAMS). This breezy entertainment concerns a gangster underling Bingo (Tsumabuki) who, to avoid getting in trouble with his boss (Nishida), sets up an elaborate sham movie production. Things get hilariously out of hand when a second-rate actor (Satô), posing as a famous hitman, is taken for the real thing by the boss. Leavened equally with screwball humor and heartwarming moments, this charmer was nominated for 8 Japanese Academy Awards.

ABOUT A BOY (2002-UK/US/France) 101m *** ½ D: Chris Weitz, Paul Weitz. Hugh Grant, Nicholas Hoult, Toni Collette, Rachel Weisz. Slacker Will (Grant) attends single parent meetings so he can hit on single moms for his own carnal needs. Will has never needed to grow up, as he's living quite comfortably on the royalties of a song written by his deceased father. Meanwhile, 12-year-old Marcus (Hoult) wants very much to make his chronically depressed single mom Fiona (Collette) happy—and decides that having Will date her is a good idea. This witty and keenly observed comedy won 11 awards. Rated PG-13.

THE STRAIGHT STORY (1999-UK/France/US) 111m *** ½ D: David Lynch (1/20/1946 – 1/15/2025). Richard Farnsworth, Sissy Spacek, Harry Dean Stanton, Jane Galloway Heit, Everett McGill. This wonderful slice of Americana (based on a true story) follows a 73-year-old Iowa man (Farnsworth) as he drives a lawnmower some 300 miles to see his ailing brother, with whom he hasn't spoken in a decade. Full of charm and faith in the basic decency of people, this film won 19 awards, including the Golden Palm at Cannes. Farnsworth was nominated for an Oscar. Rated G.

MASQUERADE HOTEL (2019-Japan) 124m *** D: Masayuki Suzuki. Takuya Kimura, Masami Nagasawa, Gaku Hamada, Fumiyo Kohinata, Takako Matsu. The police pinpoint the next place a serial killer will strike: the posh Cortesia Hotel in Tokyo. Scruffy detective Nitta (Kimura) is assigned to work undercover at the hotel front desk with ace hospitality pro Yamagishi (Nagasawa). While Yamagishi fiercely protects the privacy of her guests, Nitta must work around her to investigate them in this nifty thriller. Nominated for 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

JUROR #2 (2024-US) 114m *** ½ D: Clint Eastwood (UNFORGIVEN). Nicholas Hoult, Zoey Deutch, Toni Collette, J.K. Simmons. Family man Justin (Hoult) reluctantly serves on jury duty while his wife Allison (Deutch) is in the last stages of a difficult pregnancy. As he listens to the details in the courtroom, he realizes he knows much more about the murder case than he thought. Struggling with a serious moral dilemma, Justin tries to sway the rest of the jury in this unjustly overlooked film that won 4 awards. Rated PG-13.

KAMCHATKA (2002-Argentina/Spain/Italy) 102m *** ½ D: Marcelo Piñeyro. Ricardo Darín, Cecilia Roth, Matias Del Pozo, Milton De La Canal, Tomas Fonzi. Human rights lawyer David (Darín), his scientist wife (Roth) and their two sons Harry (Del Pozo) and 'Shrimp' (De La Canal) are forced to flee Buenos Aires during Argentina's military coup in 1976. Ten-year-old Harry cannot understand why he must leave his school and his friends, but he tries to adapt to living in a summer house in the countryside with a new identity. This sensitive portrayal of a family trying to stay together in a country falling apart won 6 awards. For ages 12 and older.

MEMOIRS OF JAPANESE ASSASSINATIONS *aka Nihon ansatsu hiroku* (1969-Japan) 142m *** D: Sadao Nakajima. Shin'ichi Chiba, Chiezô Kataoka, Kôji Tsuruta, Junko Fuji, Jirô Tamiya. On March 24, 1860, Naosuke Ii, chief minister of the Tokugawa Shogunate, was brutally assassinated by unsanctioned Mito swordsmen for signing the first treaty of commerce with the United States. So begins a century that suffered hundreds of political assassinations in Japan. What were the conditions that gave rise to this terrible turbulence? To answer this question, director Nakajima focuses on one assassin, Tadashi Onuma (Chiba), an everyman radicalized to assassinate Jinnosuke Inoue, director of the Bank of Japan in 1932. A fascinating historical drama. For ages 15 and older.

SEPTEMBER 5 (2024-Germany/US) 95m *** ½ D: Tim Fehlbaum. Peter Sarsgaard, John Magaro, Ben Chaplin, Leonie Benesch. The ABC Sports broadcast crew is in Munich relishing the 1972 Olympic Games. Mark Spitz has just won his seventh gold medal and all seems peaceful at their headquarters near the Olympic village where the athletes are housed. Suddenly, at daybreak, shots are fired nearby. Producer Geoff Mason (Magaro) rouses the rest of the crew, realizing the magnitude of the drama taking place. Their decision to live broadcast the hostage crisis changes history in this Oscar-nominated thriller based on real events. Winner of 12 awards. Rated R.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE MERRY-GO-ROUND *aka La giostra degli scambi* (2018-Italy) 111m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Sebastiano Lo Monaco, Ketty Governali. Inspector Montalbano (Zingaretti) is having a chaotic day—soon after nearly being arrested by the carabinieri he's called back home because his housekeeper (Governali) knocked out an "intruder" with a frypan. It turns out that Adelina's victim is Alfredo Virduzzo (Lo Monaco), who proves key to the arson case Montalbano is investigating. Meanwhile, young women are being abducted and released unharmed in this intricate mystery. For ages 14 and older.
