GIVE IT ALL aka Ganbatte ikimasshoi (1998-Japan) 120m *** ½ D: Itsumichi Isomura. Rena Tanaka, Masatoshi Matsuo. High school freshman Etsuko (Tanaka) feels like she fits in nowhere. Academically, she can't compare to her brilliant older sister who's off to university in Kyoto. But Etsuko's small town in Ehime, Shikoku is near the ocean, where she spots a racing shell sculling gracefully over the water. Etsuko decides to start a girls' rowing team at her high school. This beautiful coming-of-age film speaks volumes on the passion, determination and teamwork of sports. It is not a typical sports movie, it's better. Winner of 12 awards. For ages 10 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: TRACK OF SAND aka La pista di sabbia (2008-Italy) 100m **** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Isabell Sollman, Mandala Tayde, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta. While sipping his morning coffee on his terrace, Montalbano (Zingaretti) spots the body of a horse that had been killed on the beach. Infuriated with the senseless cruelty, he calls to have the cadaver removed only to have it mysteriously disappear. When, a few hours later, gorgeous Mrs. Estermann (Tayde) reports a stolen horse, Montalbano assumes it's the same horse. But the situation is much more complicated in this mystery involving horse racing and the Mafia. For ages 14 and older.

LONE WOLF AND CUB: BABY CART IN THE LAND OF DEMONS aka Kozure Ôkami: Meifumadô (1973-Japan) 89m *** ½ D: Kenji Misumi (THE TALE OF ZATOICHI). Tomisaburô Wakayama, Akihiro Tomikawa, Eiji Okada, Minoru Ôki, Michiyo Yasuda. In this fifth film of the series, Lone Wolf Ogami Ittô (Wakayama) encounters five warriors of the disgraced Kuroda clan who hire Ittô to restore the legitimate heir to the head of their fiefdom. To earn his 500-ryô fee, Ittô must defeat the five warriors, each of whom carries 100 ryôs. Little Daigorô (Tomikawa) has a challenge of his own in this creative and visually stunning adventure. For ages 15 and older.

THE KILLING aka Forbrydelsen Episodes 9 & 10 (2007-Denmark) 115m **** D: Fabian Wullenweber, Charlotte Sieling. Sofie Gråbøl, Lars Mikkelsen, Bjarne Henriksen, Farshad Kholghi, Søren Malling. When the police release schoolteacher Rama (Kholghi), Theis (Henriksen), father of the victim, reacts with violence. Under pressure from this fasco, detectives Lund (Gråbøl) and Meyer (Malling) refocus their efforts and find that their superiors withheld important evidence. They also discover that the car victim Nanna was found in had been driven from Nanna's school to City Hall. Despite being told by her boss to stay away from mayoral candidate Hartmann (Mikkelsen), Lund continues to probe. *Episode 10 completes the halfway mark of this series, which will conclude in September with Episode 20. Stick with it, folks!* For ages 15 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: FIFTY SHIPS (2003-UK) 98m **** D: Giles Foster. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Anthony Howell, Nicholas Le Prevost, Amanda Root, Henry Goodman. September 1940: A 'flying pencil' strikes Sam's (Weeks) lodging, killing a friend and leaving Sam temporarily homeless. A man is found dead on a beach, seemingly a suicide, but DCS Foyle (Kitchen) finds a worrisome connection between the deceased and wealthy American industrialist Howard Paige (Goodman) who is visiting the area. During the investigation, Foyle encounters a past love (Root). For ages 14 and older.

THE BOYS IN THE BOAT (2023-US) 123m *** ½ D: George Clooney (THE IDES OF MARCH). Joel Edgerton, Callum Turner, Peter Guinness, Hadley Robinson, Jyudah Jaymes. It is 1936 and work is hard to find. Joe Rantz (Turner) is homeless, and about to be kicked out of the University of Washington if he can't pay tuition. When he hears that the university would financially support any man who could make the rowing team, Joe jumps at the chance. This good, old fashioned underdog story set at the height of the Great Depression tells how Joe and seven other men formed a team great enough to compete at the Berlin Olympics. Winner of 2 awards. Rated PG-13.

FOYLE'S WAR: AMONG THE FEW (2003-UK) 98m **** D: Jeremy Silberston. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Julian Ovenden, Mark Umbers, Lisa Kay. Late September 1940: The police have been alerted to gasoline disappearing from a local depot. DCS Foyle (Kitchen) allows Sam (Weeks) to go undercover as a lorry driver to investigate the fuel thefts, and soon after Sam finds her co-worker Connie (Kay) is involved, Connie is found dead. The worst of it is, Foyle's RAF pilot son Andrew (Ovenden) was evidently the last one to see Connie alive in this engaging mystery. For ages 14 and older. DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: PAPER MOON aka La luna di carta (2008-Italy) 109m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Pia Lanciotti, Antonia Liskova, Angelo Russo, Cesare Bocci. Middle-aged spinster Michela (Lanciotti) reports her brother Angelo missing. Soon after, Montalbano (Zingaretti) finds Angelo dead in a rented room in a state that would suggest he had been engaging in sexual activity when he was killed. Meanwhile, Montalbano's deputy Augello (Bocci) is busy with prominent people dying of drug overdoses. Are their cases linked? This fascinating episode is leavened by plenty of humor. For ages 14 and older.

LONE WOLF AND CUB: WHITE HEAVEN IN HELL aka Kozure Ôkami: Jigoku e ikuzo! Daigorô (1974-Japan) 83m *** ½ D: Yoshiyuki Kuroda. Tomisaburô Wakayama, Akihiro Tomikawa, Junko Hitomi, Renji Ishibashi, Minoru Ôki, Isao Kimura. In this sixth and final film of the series, Lone Wolf Ogami Ittô's (Wakayama) arch-enemy Retsudô (Ôki), patriarch of the Yagyû ninja clan, has lost all of his sons in his war against Ittô and his son Daigorô. He now puts his faith in his deadly assassin daughter, Kaori (Hitomi) to finish the job. Set in a wintry landscape, this spectacular final showdown displays Wakayama's swordplay skills. For ages 15 and older.

ARTHUR THE KING (2024-US/Canada) 107m *** ½ D: Simon Cellan Jones. Mark Wahlberg, Simu Liu, Juliet Rylance, Nathalie Emmanuel, Ali Suliman, Bear Grylls, Rob Collins. Inspired by a true story, this rollicking tale concerns an endurance athlete named Michael Light (Wahlberg) who throws everything he has into one last race: the Adventure Racing World Championship in Santo Domingo, a punishing 430-mile trek that will require rock climbing, paddling, hiking and running through rough terrain. Along the way, Michael's team befriends a dog they call Arthur, who ends up becoming the team's savior. This heartwarmer won 1 award. Rated PG-13.

FOYLE'S WAR: WAR GAMES (2003-UK) 99m **** D: Giles Foster. Michael Kitchen, Ian Redford, Laurence Fox, Alan Howard, Emily Blunt, Honeysuckle Weeks. October 1940: DCS Foyle (Kitchen) is pressed into serving as referee at the Home Guard's war games held at food corporation tyccon Sir Reginald Walker's (Redford) estate. Sir Reginald's safe was robbed the night before, but curiously, it wasn't reported to the police. When someone dies during the war games exercise, Foyle uncovers a sinister plot with the help of kids collecting paper and scrap metal in this entertaining episode. For ages 14 and older.

THE SEPARATION *aka La séparation* (1994-France) 84m *** D: Christian Vincent (COURTED). Isabelle Huppert, Daniel Auteuil, Jérôme Deschamps, Karin Viard, Laurence Lerel, Louis Vincent. In this acting master class, French superstars Isabelle Huppert and Daniel Auteuil are Anne and Pierre, a couple whose relationship is beginning to fray. While watching a film, Pierre touches Anne's hand and she irritably pulls it away. A hurt gaze that's not met, a question not answered. Soon the fabric of a life together is irreparably torn in this keenly observed drama. Nominated for 3 awards. Rated PG.

THE DANCING DETECTIVE: A DEADLY TANGO (2023-UK/ Malta/Canada) 84m *** D: Stefan Scaini. Lacey Chabert, Will Kemp, Bettina Paris, Natasa Babic, Diego Wallraff. No-nonsense detective Constance (Chabert) is sent undercover to the gorgeous island of Malta to investigate the murder of a high-profile CEO. To her surprise, her new identity requires that she participate in a corporate ballroom competition—and she can't dance. To remedy this, she's paired with dance instructor Sebastian (Kemp), who is a big fan of TV detective shows (much to Constance's annoyance). A cozy charmer. Rated G.

THE KILLING aka Forbrydelsen Episodes 11 & 12 (2007-Denmark) 114m **** D: Charlotte Sieling, Henrik Ruben Genz. Sofie Gråbøl, Lars Mikkelsen, Søren Malling, Marie Askehave, Bjarne Henkiksen, Ann Eleonora Jørgensen. Detective Lund's (Gråbøl) persistence hits paydirt in the discovery of a new crime scene which implicates Hartmann's campaign. Pernille (Jørgensen), Nanna's mother, learns of her daughter's secret affair with someone named "Faust". The clues all lead toward Hartmann, who insists he's innocent. The investigation takes a terrible toll on the personal lives of all involved, including Lund's. For ages 15 and older.

NOWHERE SPECIAL (2020-Italy/Romania/UK) 96m *** ½ D: Uberto Pasolini (STILL LIFE). James Norton, Daniel Lamont, Carol Moore, Eileen O'Higgins. John (Norton) is a 35-year-old Belfast window cleaner. He's a single dad, with a quiet and observant four-year-old son named Michael (Lamont). Each day it becomes harder for John to provide for Michael, as John is terminally ill. In this beautiful and heartfelt drama, John interviews prospective adoptive parents for Michael, who, though he hasn't the vocabulary to discuss it, grieves the prospect of losing his father. Winner of 5 awards. For ages 12 and older. WICKED LITTLE LETTERS (2023-UK/US/ France) 100m *** ½ D: Thea Sharrock (ME BEFORE YOU). Olivia Colman, Jessie Buckley, Timothy Spall, Anjana Vasan, Gemma Jones, Malachi Kirby. In this riotous comedy set in an English seaside town in the 1920s, God-fearing goody-two-shoes Edith (Colman) has been receiving shocking profanity-filled letters ever since rowdy Irish migrant Rose Gooding (Buckley) moved to town. When others in the community begin to get wicked letters, Rose is charged with the crime. Police officer Gladys Moss (Vasan), however, suspects something is amiss and looks for the real culprit in this delightful mystery. Rated R.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE POTTER'S FIELD aka II campo del vasaio (2011-Italy) 109m **** D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Isabell Sollman, Angelo Russo, Belén Rodríguez, Marcello Perracchio. Something is up with Montalbano's (Zingaretti) already mercurial deputy Mimi (Bocci). He's been so erratic and irritable he's even made sweet Catarella (Russo) cry. After a little digging, Montalbano finds that Mimì is in big Mafia trouble—as in voluptuous, leggy, high-heeled trouble (Rodríguez). It will take all of Montalbano's wit and guile to rescue him in this corker of an episode. For ages 14 and older.

THE OLD GUN aka Le vieux fusil (1975-France/ West Germany) 98m *** ½ D: Robert Enrico. Philippe Noiret (CINEMA PARADISO), Romy Schneider, Jean Bouise, Joachim Hansen, Robert Hoffmann. Set in 1944, during the last months of the German occupation of France, this war drama concerns Julien Dandieu (Noiret), a surgeon at the hospital of Montauban. Dandieu is a family man; his activities with the Resistance involve little risk. With liberation near, Dr. Dandieu moves his wife and daughter to the family castle. When he visits one week later and discovers the Nazis have arrived at the castle, he retrieves the long-stashed shotgun of his childhood. Movie Museum presents a rare screening of this deeply moving revenge thriller. English language version-there are no English subtitled versions of this film. Winner of 4 film awards. Rated R.

THE LONG GAME (2023-US) 113m *** D: Julio Quintana. Jay Hernandez, Dennis Quaid, Cheech Marin, Julian Works, Jaina Lee Ortiz, Oscar Nuñez, Miguel Angel Garcia, Jimmy Gonzales. In this touching sports drama set in 1955, five high schoolers, all caddies at the same exclusive country club, build their own golf course in the South Texas desert—because as Mexican Americans, they aren't allowed to play golf. Adapted from Humberto G. Garcia's memoir, this inspiring true story is about these boys and their school superintendent, JB Peña (Hernandez), who build a golf team to compete at the 1957 Texas State High School Golf Championship. Winner of 1 award. Rated PG.

THE KILLING aka Forbrydelsen Episodes 13 & 14 (2007-Denmark) 114m **** D: Henrik Ruben Genz, Fabian Wullenweber. Sofie Gråbøl, Lars Mikkelsen, Søren Malling, Marie Askehave, Bjarne Henkiksen, Ann Eleonora Jørgensen, Morten Suurballe. The full glare of the police and public spotlight is on mayoral candidate Hartmann (Mikkelsen) as his alibi falls apart under scrutiny. Though he refuses to say where he was on the night of the murder, detective Lund (Gråbøl) has deduced that he's innocent. Why won't he speak? Meanwhile, Nanna's once happy family is falling apart. For ages 15 and older.

ROBO-G (2012-Japan) 111m *** ½ D: Shinobu Yaguchi (WATER BOYS). Gaku Hamada, Mickey Curtis, Chan Kawai, Junya Kawashima, Naoto Takenaka. When an accident causes the hard work of Kimura Electrical Co.'s robotics team to go out the window (literally), the three nerds of the research department (Kawai, Hamada and Kawashima) hatch a desperate plan: They hire retiree Suzuki (Curtis) to don a robot suit to fake a demo at the robotics expo. This charming comedy was nominated for an award. For ages 10 and older.
