THE KILLING aka Forbrydelsen Episodes 15 & 16 (2007-Denmark) 117m \*\*\*\* D: Morten Arnfred, Kristoffer Nyholm. Sofie Gråbøl, Lars Mikkelsen, Bjarne Henriksen, Ann Eleonora Jørgensen, Søren Malling. Though mayoral candidate Hartmann (Mikkelsen) finally proves his innocence, to his great frustration, the police refuse to release him from custody. Meanwhile, detective Lund (Gråbøl) walks into a life-threatening struggle in pursuit of the new suspect in this electrifying set of episodes. For ages 15 and older.

IN THE LAND OF SAINTS AND SINNERS (2023-Ireland) 106m \*\*\* D: Robert Lorenz. Liam Neeson, Kerry Condon, Colm Meany, Ciarán Hinds, Jack Gleeson, Desmond Eastwood. Hitman Finbar Murphy (Neeson) is trying to put down his gun and peacefully retire in the little town of Glencolmcille, County Donegal. Though he's sworn off killing, he can't resist ridding Glencolmcille of a scumbag (Eastwood) who's molesting a child. Unfortunately, the scumbag is Curtis, brother of vicious IRA leader Doireann McCann (Condon). Finbar is compelled to protect his community from the carnage in this thriller set in 1970s Ireland. Nominated for 2 awards. Rated R.

A KILLER'S KEY aka Aru koroshiya no kagi (1967-Japan) 79m \*\*\* D: Kazuo Mori (A CERTAIN KILLER). Raizô Ichikawa, Kô Nishimura, Tomomi Satô. To most who know him, Nitta (Ichikawa) is an elegant teacher of classical Japanese dance. But in the underworld, he has a fearsome reputation as a contract killer. Meticulously precise, cautious and cold-blooded, Nitta is chosen by the top brass of the mob to kill a politician. But when one of his students (Satô) blunders onto the scene, things get complicated. The story of this superior thriller was developed by master filmmaker Yasuzô Masumura. For ages 12 and older.

WHEN IN ROME aka Rom (2024-Denmark/ Italy/Sweden) 96m \*\*\* D: Niclas Bendixen. Bodil Jørgensen, Kristian Halken, Rolf Lassgård (WAL-LANDER). Danish couple Gerda (Jørgensen) and Kristoffer (Halken) travel to Rome to celebrate their 40th wedding anniversary in this delightful comedy/drama. Gerda, full of spunk, wants to dance under the stars while Kristoffer nurses his delicate stomach and tries gamely to keep up. Gerda, who had studied art in Rome as a young woman, bumps into an old flame, rekindling dreams of a life she left behind while Kristoffer watches in dismay. What will he do? For ages 12 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: THE FUNK HOLE (2003-UK) 99m \*\*\*\* D: Jeremy Silberston. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Nicholas Farrell, Anthony Howell, Julian Ovenden, Richard Hope. October 1940: Upon returning to Hastings from a visit to London, DCS Foyle (Kitchen) is outraged to hear he's suspended from duty for spreading alarm in a London bomb shelter. To make matters worse, his RAF pilot son Andrew (Ovenden) is injured in a flying mission. During an investigation of stolen food being sold on the black market, Foyle's replacement, Chief Inspector Collier (Farrell), visits a "funk hole", a country mansion where rich people pay to stay to avoid the war. Soon after, one of the residents is found dead by cyanide poisoning in this intricate mystery. For ages 14 and older.

THE WIDOW COUDERC aka La veuve Couderc (1971-France/Italy) 86m \*\*\* ½ D: Pierre Granier-Deferre. Alain Delon (11/8/1935–8/18/2024), Simone Signoret, Ottavia Piccolo, Jean Tissier. In small Burgundian village in 1934, a middle-aged widow (Signoret) shelters a man on the run (Delon). The stern Mme. Couderc, despite her hard years on the farm, begins to fall for the footloose younger man in this touching drama. His eyes, however, are on Félicie (Piccolo), the nubile young neighbor. For ages 14 and older.

HOTARU THE MOVIE aka Hotaru no hikari (2012-Japan) 110m \*\*\* D: Hiroshi Yoshino. Haruka Ayase (ICHI), Naohito Fujiki, Yuya Tegoshi, Yasuko Matsuyuki. Hotaru (Ayase) is a self-confessed "himono onna" or "dried fish woman"—a twenty-something who works so hard at her job she has no energy or desire to leave home. So when her loving hubby Seiichi (Fujiki) asks her to travel to Rome with him, it takes all of her courage and strength to say "Yes". This charming comedy details Hotaru's adventures in Rome, where Hotaru begins to re-examine her life. For ages 12 and older.

ARMAGUEDON (1977-France/Italy/Belgium) 93m \*\*\* D: Alain Jessua (SHOCK TREATMENT). Alain Delon (11/8/1935-8/18/2024), Jean Yanne, Renato Salvatori. Repairman Carrier (Yanne) inherits a small fortune and decides to make his mark on the world. With his feeble-minded accomplice "Einstein" (Salvatori), Carrier, under the name of "Armageddon", sends a series of threatening messages by cassette tape to various European government ministers, bank presidents, even to Mick Jagger. Initially seen as a crackpot, his threats become lethal. Criminal psychologist Dr. Ambrose (Delon) is called in to catch the increasingly unhinged killer. For ages 15 and older.

THE TEACHER WHO PROMISED THE SEA aka El maestro que prometió el mar (2023-Spain) 105m \*\*\* ½ D: Patricia Font. Enric Auguer, Laia Costa, Luisa Gavasa, Nicolas Calvo, Ramon Agirre, Gael Aparicio, Milo Taboada. Young Barcelona mother Arianna (Costa) visits her grandfather at his retirement home to let him know that a mass grave was found where his father's remains may have been buried during the Spanish Civil War. As her grandfather is unable to travel, Arianna travels to Burgos to the gravesite. While there, Arianna meets an older gentleman named Emilio (Agirre) who introduces her to the world her grandfather lived as a child, and their teacher (Auguer) who opened their eyes to the world. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE GULL'S DANCE aka La danza del gabbiano (2011-Italy) 112m \*\*\* ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Sebastiano Rapisarda. On a quiet morning at the police station, Montalbano (Zingaretti) is surprised by a visit from Carmine (Rapisarda), Inspector Giuseppe Fazio's (Mazzotta) father, asking the whereabouts of his son. After telling Carmine a plausible lie, Montalbano galvanizes the team to search for Giuseppe. Frightened and grim-faced, Montalbano and Mimì (Bocci) scramble when evidence indicates Fazio is in mortal danger in this tense episode. For ages 14 and older.

THE KILLING aka Forbrydelsen Episodes 17 & 18 (2007-Denmark) 115m \*\*\*\* D: Kristoffer Nyholm, Morten Køhlert. Sofie Gråbøl, Søren Malling, Morten Suurballe, Lars Mikkelsen, Bent Mejding, Bjarne Henriksen, Ann Eleonora Jørgensen. Though her boss Brix (Suurballe) and her partner Meyer (Malling) insist the case is closed, detective Lund (Gråbøl) can't shake the suspicion that the killer is linked to an unsolved case and still at large. When Lund shows up at their door with more questions, Nana's parents' (Henriksen and Jørgensen) hard-won peace is disturbed by allegations that one of their employees may be the killer. For ages 15 and older.

WOOD JOB! aka Kamisari nânâ nichijô (2014-Japan) 116m \*\*\*\* ½ D: Shinobu Yaguchi (WATER BOYS). Shôta Sometani, Masami Nagasawa, Hideaki Itô, Dumped by his girlfriend and dejected after failing his university entrance exams, Yuki (Sometani) enrolls in a forestry training program because of the pretty girl (Nagasawa) on the pamphlet cover. The training is tough, there's no cellular reception and the girl, Naoki, disdains him. But the smell of the trees, the crystal clean air, the way the mist settles in the deep green forest (and the oddball villagers) are changing Yuki's view of the world. This delightful comedy won an award. For ages 12 and up.

THE KILLING aka Forbrydelsen Episodes 19 & 20 Final Episode! (2007-Denmark) 118m \*\*\*\* D: Kristoffer Nyholm. Sofie Gråbøl, Morten Suurballe, Lars Mikkelsen, Bjarne Henriksen, Ann Eleonora Jørgensen, Nikolaj Kopernikus. In this explosive conclusion of the series, detective Lund (Gråbøl), suspected of shooting her partner Meyer (Malling), goes on the run from the police to pursue Nana's killer, believing Nana's father Theis (Henriksen) is in mortal danger. Mayoral candidate Hartmann (Mikkelsen) makes a terrible discovery while on the verge of political victory. This brilliant political crime series won 12 awards, including a BAFTA. For ages 15 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: THE FRENCH DROP (2004-UK) 93m \*\*\*\*\* D: Gavin Millar. Michael Kitchen, Samuel West, Honeysuckle Weeks, Anthony Howell, Ronald Pickup. February 1941: Itching to contribute to the war effort, DCS Foyle (Kitchen) pursues a position with Naval Intelligence in Liverpool. Meanwhile, he investigates a presumed suicide by explosion: the only piece of hard evidence is a gold pocket watch. The victim is believed to be William Messinger, son of Sir Giles Messinger (Pickup), head of military intelligence. William joined the Special Operations Executive, a rival intelligence unit led by Col. Wintringham (West), for whom Sir Giles holds great contempt. For ages 14 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: TREASURE HUNT aka La caccia al tesoro (2011-Italy) 100m \*\*\* ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Isabell Sollman, Alessandro Intini, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta. A pair of elderly religious fanatics get trigger happy one afternoon, causing Montalbano (Zingaretti) and Fazio (Mazzotta) to forcibly enter their creepy apartment to arrest them. Among the many religious items they find in the flat is an inflatable life-size doll. After this incident makes the national news on TV, Montalbano begins to receive cryptic messages inviting him on a treasure hunt. The closer he gets to finding the "treasure", the more terrifying the hunt becomes in this spooky episode. For ages 14 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: THE AGE OF DOUBT aka L'età del dubbio (2011-Italy) 103m \*\*\* ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Ana Caterina Morariu, Isabella Ragonese. While driving, Montalbano (Zingaretti) spots a traffic jam caused by a rockfall and gives a young woman (Morariu), whose car had stalled, a ride. She says she plans to see her aunt at the harbor, whose yacht, the Vanna, is due to arrive. Later at the police station, when Montalbano receives a report that the crew of the Vanna encountered a dead body on a dinghy, he discovers the niece isn't who she says she is. Puzzled, Montalbano begins to suspect foul play. For ages 14 and older.

THE FALL GUY (2024-US/Australia/Canada) 126m \*\*\*\*/y. D: David Leitch (BULLET TRAIN). Ryan Gosling, Emily Blunt, Aaron Taylor-Johnson, Hannah Waddingham (Ted Lasso). In this hugely entertaining love story, stuntman Colt (Gosling) adores camera operator Jody (Blunt) until an on-set accident nearly ends his career. Eighteen months later, Colt tries to win back Jody as a stuntman in a sci-fi film she's directing in this action comedy that simultaneously lampoons and celebrates moviemaking. Naturally, long-time stuntman and action choreographer David Leitch won an Astra Midseason Award for Best Stunts for this film. Rated PG-13. Note: Happy Birthday, Liam 9/23! Here's a movie to enjoy when you're older.

EZRA (2023-US) 101m \*\*\* D: Tony Goldwyn (feature debut). Bobby Cannavale, William A. Fitzgerald, Rose Byrne, Robert De Niro, Whoopi Goldberg, Vera Farmiga, Jimmy Kimmel. Ezra (Fitzgerald) has read the New York Times since he was 5, loves old movies and has perfect comedic timing. But he's been expelled from his elementary school, as his autism makes it hard to conform. His mom Jenna (Byrne) thinks he should enroll in a special needs school and take medication. His stand-up comedian dad Max (Cannavale), who is all heart, disagrees, and makes an impulsive decision that changes the course of his and Ezra's lives in this beautifully crafted comedy-drama. Winner of 3 awards. Rated R.

FOYLE'S WAR: ENEMY FIRE (2004-UK) 93m \*\*\*\* D: Jeremy Silberston. Michael Kitchen, John Wood, Shaun Dooley, Honeysuckle Weeks, Julian Ovenden, Anthony Howell. Late February 1941: Soon after Sir Michael Waterford's (Wood) estate is commandeered to house a burn unit for injured RAF pilots, DCS Foyle is called there to investigate a series of accidents. Suspicion falls on an RAF mechanic, Gordon Drake (Dooley), who lives on the estate. Foyle's son Andrew (Ovenden), an RAF pilot, also has testy exchanges with Drake for his negligence. Andrew suffers from severe battle fatigue and goes AWOL—in Sam's (Weeks) flat. For ages 14 and older.
