RHYTHM IS IT! (2004-Germany) 101m *** ½ D: Thomas Grube, Enrique Sánchez Lansch. In 2003, the Berlin Philharmonic launched an ambitious education project: teach 250 disadvantaged young people from 25 different countries to perform in Igor Stravinsky's riveting but difficult ballet 'Le Sacre du Printemps'. In this film, conductor Sir Simon Rattle and choreographer Royston Maldoom transform the easily distracted group of children and young adults into focused and expressive dancers. This thrilling documentary won 6 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE LAST RIFLEMAN (2023-Ireland/UK) 99m *** D: Terry Loane (MICKYBO AND ME). Pierce Brosnan, Clémence Poésy, John Amos, Jürgen Prochnow, Ian McElhinney. World War II veteran Artie Crawford (Brosnan), grieving from the recent loss of his wife, escapes his care home in Northern Ireland and embarks on a journey to France to attend the 75th anniversary of the D-Day landings. Artie, who is too stubborn to pay much attention to his medical needs, is helped along the way by young Frenchwoman Juliette (Poésy) and catches a ride on a bus with German vet Friedrich (Prochnow). Nominated for 2 awards. Rated PG-13.

THE NEPHEW (1998-Ireland) 100m *** D: Eugene Brady. Hill Harper, Donal McCann, Pierce Brosnan, Sinéad Cusack, Aislin McGuckin. Friendly Chad (Harper), a 17-year-old New Yorker, arrives in a small Irish island town to visit his estranged uncle Tony (McCann), a grumpy and narrowminded farmer. The little town is abuzz about the handsome dreadlocked stranger, un-locking closets full of skeletons in this breezy romantic comedy-drama. A delightful Celtic soundtrack and gorgeous scenery make this film a treat for eyes and ears. Rated PG-13.

NABBIE'S LOVE (1999-Japan) 92m *** ½ D: Yuji Nakae. Naomi Nishida, Tomi Taira, Jun Murakami, Seijin Noborikawa, Susumu Taira. In this charming comedy-drama, Nanako (Nishida) quits her job in Tokyo and returns to her home on a small Okinawan island to find her grandmother Nabbie (Tomi Taira) involved in a torrid affair. Funny and full of color and music, this gem won 7 awards, including one from Berlin. For ages 12 and older.

CONVERSATIONS WITH MY GARDENER (2007-France) 106m *** D: Jean Becker. Daniel Auteuil, Jean-Pierre Darroussin. A successful painter (Auteuil), weary of life in Paris, returns to his childhood home upon the death of his parents. He hires a gardener to tame the overgrown land to re-create his mother's vegetable garden and discovers the gardener (Darroussin) is an old childhood friend. As the two reacquaint themselves, the urban sophisticate and the rural pragmatist discover they have much to share in wisdom and humor. Nominated for a César, For ages 12 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: ANGELICA'S SMILE aka Il sorriso di Angelica (2013-Italy) 112m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Margareth Madè, Lina Perned, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Angelo Russo. Detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) puzzles over a series of burglaries of Sicily's wealthiest that all feature sleeping gas. Evidently the victims all belong to the same group of friends. One of the victims is the bewitchingly beautiful Angelica (Madè), who isn't as innocent as she seems. For ages 14 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: THEY FOUGHT IN THE FIELDS (2004-UK) 91m **** D: Jeremy Silberston. Michael Kitchen, Nigel Terry, Trevor Cooper, Joe Armstrong, Honeysuckle Weeks, Stella Gonet, Anthony Howell. April 1941: DCS Foyle (Kitchen) investigates the death of farmer Hugh Jackson (Terry) and finds that a number of people may have wanted to kill him. He was in a land dispute with his neighbor (Cooper); his son Tom (Armstrong) stood to inherit the farm; and to top it off, three German airmen had recently parachuted onto his land. Strangely, all of the evidence seems to point to prickly man-hating botanist Barbara Hicks (Gonet). For ages 14 and older.

THE FOREIGN DUCK, THE NATIVE DUCK AND GOD IN A COIN LOCKER aka Ahiru to kamo no koinrokkâ (2007-Japan) 110m *** ½ D: Yoshihiro Nakamura (A BOY AND HIS SAMURAI). Gaku Hamada (FISH STORY), Eita Nagayama, Kei Tamura, Megumi Seki, Ryûhei Matsuda, Nene Ôtsuka. Guileless Shiina (Hamada) moves into an apartment in Sendai to start his first year of college. He befriends his quirky neighbor Kawasaki (Nagayama), who insists they rob a bookstore to obtain a kanji dictionary for their Bhutanese neighbor (Tamura). Shiina goes on a wild ride with Kawasaki to discover why in this delightful comedydrama-mystery. For ages 15 and older. FAREWELL MR. HAFFMANN aka Adieu Monsieur Haffmann (2021-France/Belgium) 112m *** ½ D: Fred Cavayé (ANYTHING FOR HER). Daniel Auteuil, Gilles Lellouche, Sara Giraudeau. Polish-born French citizen Joseph Haffmann (Auteuil) has seen violent Jew-hatred before. Sensing danger, in 1942 he moves his family out of Paris to the free zone, where he hopes to join them. Haffmann entrusts his jewelry store to his employee François (Lellouche) to operate while he is in exile. But Haffmann stays in Paris too long, forcing him to hide in his cellar as German forces fill the streets. This compelling tale of human nature won an award. For ages 12 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: A WAR OF NERVES (2004-UK) 93m **** D: Gavin Millar. Michael Kitchen, Anthony Howell, Corin Redgrave, Peter Capaldi, Honeysuckle Weeks, June 1941: This suspenseful episode delves into the nerve-shattering work of WWI sappers, who dispose of unexploded German bombs. DCS Foyle (Kitchen) is investigating a black market ring and its connection with Talbot shipyards when an unexploded bomb falls in one of the shipyard warehouses. Foyle is forced to delegate most of the work to Sgt. Milner (Howell) as Asst. Commissioner Rose (Redgrave) insists that Foyle drop everything to shadow Socialist activist Carter (Capaldi). For ages 14 and older.

ASHES IN THE SKY aka Un cel de plom (2023-Spain) 102m *** D: Miquel Romans. Nausicaa Bonnín, Natàlia Barrientos, Iria del Río, Roger Batalla, Rachel Lascar. After a year in Ravensbrück extermination camp, Catalan republican Neus (Bonnín) reunites with her family in France in 1945. She recalls the events of the past year, when she and a group of women sabotaged a bullet factory where they were forced to labor. Adapted from Carme Martí's biography of anti-fascist activist Neus Català, this compelling biopic was nominated for an award. For ages 15 and older.

ONE STAYS, ONE LEAVES aka L'un reste, l'autre part (2005-France) 94m *** D: Claude Berri (HUNTING AND GATHERING). Daniel Auteuil, Charlotte Gainsbourg, Nathalie Baye, Pierre Arditi, Miou-Miou, Aïssa Maïga. The complications of love in mid-life are explored in this picaresque comedy of infidelity. Daniel (Auteuil), grief-stricken when his son Julien is injured in a motorcycle accident, falls for sympathetic young Judith (Gainsbourg), causing equal amounts of ecstasy and anguish. Daniel's friend Alain (Arditi) falls for glamazon Farida (Maïga) and gets an ultimatum from his wife Fanny (Baye). Who will stay and who will leave? For ages 15 and older.

THE LAST RECIPE aka Kirin no shita no kioku (2017-Japan) 126m *** ½ D: Yôjirô Takita (DEPARTURES). Kazunari Ninomiya, Hidetoshi Nishijima, Aoi Miyazaki. Failed chef Sasaki (Ninomiya) is eking out a living by cooking "last meals" for elderly people. He has a special talent: he's known to have a "Qilin tongue", the ability to perfectly re-create any dish he's tasted. His powers are put to the ultimate test when a client from Beijing challenges Sasaki to re-create a Japanese Imperial feast prepared in Manchuria in the late 1930s. For ages 12 and older.

THE EXAM aka A vizsga (2011-Hungary) 89m *** ½ D: Péter Bergendy. János Kulka, Zsolt Nagy. The 1956 Hungarian Revolution has failed; Budapest is under surveillance by the Communist secret police. Young National Security officer Jung (Nagy) lives undercover as a teacher, using his apartment as a safe place to meet informers and fellow agents. When Jung's friend and mentor Markó (Kulka) is tasked with testing Jung's loyalty to the Party, he is deeply conflicted when Jung's private life reveals dangerous secrets. Winner of 4 awards. For ages 15 and older.

SAKURAN (2006-Japan) 111m *** D: Mika Ninagawa. Anna Tsuchiya (KAMIKAZE GIRLS), Kippei Shiina, Yoshino Kimura, Hiroki Narimiya, Miho Kanno, Masatoshi Nagase. This over-the-top celebration of the Edo-period brothels of Yoshiwara has as its heroine feisty Kiyoha (Tsuchiya). Rising through the ranks to become a top Oiran, she realizes that to win her freedom she must leave Yoshiwara on the arm of a rich patron. Along the way, true love proves an obstacle. Visually stylish in unorthodox ways and propelled by an eclectic jazz/rock soundtrack by pop diva Ringo Shiina, this sensual cinematic manga was nominated for 4 awards. Suitable for ages 15 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: HALL OF MIRRORS aka Il gioco degli specchi (2013-Italy) 113m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Barbora Bobulova, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Andrea Renzi, Angelo Russo. Bombs have been exploding next to the doors of abandoned warehouses. The entire Vigàta police can figure out neither who planted the bombs nor who they are meant for—until detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) gets friendly with Liliana (Bobulova), his leggy new neighbor. For ages 14 and older. IRATI (2022-Spain/France) 107m *** D: Paul Urkijo Alijo (ERREMENTARI). Eneko Sagardoy, Edurne Azkarate, Itziar Ituño, Kepa Errasti, Iñigo Aranbarri. Ancient history and legends come alive in this visually striking tale set in the Basque territory in 778 AD. The Lord of the Vale (Aranbarri) makes a pact with pagan high priestess Mari (Ituño) to protect his people against Frankish invaders, at a terrible price. His exiled son Eneko (Sagardoy), who seeks to regain his family's rule of the land, is introduced to a mysterious realm of magic by pagan girl Irati (Azkarate). Winner of 2 awards. For ages 15 and older. *RED-G turns 4! A movie to enjoy when you're older!*

FURIOSA: A MAD MAX SAGA (2024-Australia/ US) 148m *** ½ D: George Miller (MAD MAX: FURY ROAD). Anya Taylor-Joy, Chris Hemsworth, Tom Burke, Lachy Hulme. This wild tale serves as the origin story of Furiosa (Taylor-Joy) set in the time before she meets Mad Max in FURY ROAD. Snatched from the Green Place by the biker horde led by the warlord Dementus (Hemsworth), young Furiosa struggles to survive when Dementus tries to take over the Citadel by battling tyrant Immortan Joe (Hulme). This over-the-top action epic won an award. Rated R.

THE WOODSMAN AND THE RAIN aka Kitsutsuki to Ame (2011-Japan) 129m *** D: Shûichi Okita. Kôji Yakusho, Shun Oguri, Tsutomu Yamazaki, Kengo Kôra, Masato Ibu. In a mountain forest, 60-year-old lumberjack Katsuhiko (Yakusho) cuts down a tree. As it crashes down, he's nervously approached by a man who tells him to be quict. Puzzled, Katsuhiko discovers that the man is the assistant director of a zombie movie being filmed nearby, and the film's inexperienced director Koichi (Oguri) hasn't a clue what he's doing. The woodsman and the director become unlikely friends in this touching comedy. Winner of 4 awards. For ages 12 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: A VOICE IN THE NIGHT aka Una voce di notte (2013-Italy) 106m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Andrea Croci, Peppino Mazzotta, Cesare Bocci, Giacinto Ferro. Detective Salvo Montalbano's (Zingaretti) birthday isn't going well. After nearly being run off the road and threatened with a bat at a gas station, Montalbano throws road rager Giovanni Strangio (Croci) in a cell at the police station. Unfortunately, Giovanni's dad is a powerful politician who swears to end both Montalbano's and his boss Commissioner Alderighi's (Ferro) careers. For ages 14 and older.

FAMILY JEWELS aka Eierdiebe (2003-Germany) 84m *** D: Robert Schwentke (THE CAPTAIN). Wotan Wilke Möhring, Julia Hummer, Antoine Monot Jr., Alexander Beyer. University student Martin's (Möhring) life takes a wide detour when he is diagnosed with testicular cancer in this hilarious black comedy. As Martin is subjected to the indignities of his medical treatment, he decides to win back his self-respect by stealing back his "family jewel" from the hospital pathology lab. Winner of 3 awards. For ages 12 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: INVASION (2006-UK) 94m **** D: Gavin Millar. Michael Kitchen, Jay Benedict, Honeysuckle Weeks, Anthony Howell, Keith Barron. March 1942: The US Army Corps of Engineers arrives in Hastings to build an airfield and gets a less than warm welcome: local farmer Barrett (Barron) chases the Yanks off (what was) his land with a shotgun. US Capt. Kieffer (Benedict) asks DCS Foyle (Kitchen) for help with this matter, and the two begin to hit it off as friends. But when a British citizen dies on the US military base, US-Anglo relations are strained in this engaging episode. For ages 14 and older.

FAST CHARLIE (2023-US) 90m *** D: Phillip Noyce (SALT). Pierce Brosnan, Morena Baccarin, James Caan, Gbenga Akinnagbe, Brennan Keel Cook. Hitman Charlie Swift (Brosnan) has a problem. He managed to kill his target Rollo, whose body is missing its head. How is he going to prove to New Orleans' most ruthless mobster, Beggar Mercado (Akkinagbe), that he's done the job? Charlie enlists the help of Rollo's ex-wife Marcie (Baccarin) in this funny and oddly heartfelt mobster movie. For ages 15 and older.
