**HORIZON: AN AMERICAN SAGA – Chapter 1 (2024-US)** 181m \*\*\* ½ D: Kevin Costner (DANCES WITH WOLVES). Kevin Costner, Sienna Miller, Sam Worthington, Owen Crow Shoe, Luke Wilson, Danny Huston, Abbey Lee. In this first chapter of a sweeping 3-part Western epic set in 1859, white settlers arrive in the San Pedro Valley under the watchful eyes of the Apache inhabitants. Meanwhile, in Wyoming territory, horse trader Hayes (Costner) gets embroiled in a nasty family feud with the Sykes clan. A long wagon train is trundling west, its volatile mix of restless settlers and their nervous animals barely kept under control by wagon boss Van Weyden (Wilson). This visually awe-inspiring epic excites with moments of heart-jumping action. Rated R.

**FOYLE'S WAR: BAD BLOOD (2006-UK)** 93m \*\*\*\* D: Jeremy Silberston. Michael Kitchen, Honeysuckle Weeks, Anthony Howell, Jonah Lotan, Caroline Martin, Tim Delap, Anthony Flanagan. August 1942: Farm animals are dying of a mysterious disease, and not long after, a farmer's daughter dies in the hospital with strange black lesions on her skin. Sgt. Milner (Howell) is asked by former love Edie (Martin) for help regarding her conscientious objector brother Martin (Delap), who's accused of killing a war hero (Flanagan). Meanwhile, Sam (Weeks) falls ill after visiting a farm... For ages 14 and older.

**THE BIG SICK (2017-US)** 120m \*\*\*\* D: Michael Showalter (HELLO, MY NAME IS DORIS). Kumail Nanjiani, Zoe Kazan, Holly Hunter, Ray Romano, Anupam Kher. Pakistan-born Chicagoan Kumail (Nanjiani) would like nothing better than to please his loving but strict Muslim parents. Whenever he comes home to visit, single (mom-approved) women just happen to drop by for dinner. But stand-up comedian Kumail is in love with Emily (Kazan), though loving her is sure to get him disowned. When Emily falls ill, the stakes rise even higher. This funny, deep and moving comedy-drama won 4 awards. Rated R.

**THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: DAY OF THE DEAD (2024-New Zealand)** 96m \*\*\*\* D: Geoff Cawthorn. Neill Rea, Fern Sutherland, Jarod Rawiri, Cristina Serban Ionda, Karl Willets, Kauri Williams. The Brokenwood SSA (Small Stallholders Association) puts on a festive Día de los Muertos festival with spooky effigies hanging everywhere, including (as it turns out) a real dead body. Nursing a mean tequila-induced hangover, Frodo (Willets) and his friends try to help detectives Mike (Rea) and Kristin (Sutherland) find the murderer in this colorful episode. For ages 14 and older.

**THE MINISTRY OF UNGENTLEMANLY WARFARE (2024-US/UK/Turkey)** 122m \*\*\* D: Guy Ritchie (SNATCH). Henry Cavill, Alan Ritchson, Rory Kinnear, Eiza González, Cary Elwes, Henry Golding, Til Schweiger, Freddie Fox. Inspired by real events, this action comedy tells the story of the first special forces group organized by UK Prime Minister Winston Churchill (Kinnear). The top-secret combat unit, composed of assorted rogues and mavericks (including author Ian Fleming (Fox)), is deployed on a mission against the Nazis using highly ungentlemanly tactics. The Wrap says, "(Ritchie) strikes a fine, fun balance between the threat that the Nazis posed and the thrill of watching hunky heroes slaughter them". Rated R.

**BEYOND aka Svinälängorna (2010-Sweden/Finland/Denmark)** 95m \*\*\* ½ D: Pernilla August. Noomi Rapace, Ola Rapace, Outi Mäenpää, Ville Virtanen, Tehilla Blad, Junior Blad. Happily married mother of two girls, Leena (Noomi Rapace), is jolted out of her peaceful routine by a call from her estranged mother (Mäenpää) on St. Lucia Day. Leena, who had avoided talking about her parents for years, travels with her family to far away Ystad to visit her dying mother. Along the way she recalls her traumatic childhood, trying to shield her loving husband (Noomi's real husband Ola Rapace) and children from her grief and rage. This powerfully truthful and moving drama won 11 awards. For ages 15 and older.

**SHANGHAI (2010-China/US)** 104m \*\*\* D: Mikael Häfström. John Cusack, Gong Li, Chow Yun-Fat, Ken Watanabe, Franka Potente, Benedict Wong, Jeffrey Dean Morgan, David Morse. US Naval intelligence officer Soames (Cusack) travels to Shanghai in 1941 to investigate the death of his friend Connor (Morgan) but gets romantically entangled with Anna (Li), the beautiful wife of local triad leader Anthony Lan-Ting (Chow Yun-Fat), who has fingers in every pie. Shanghai is the only major Chinese city that hasn't fallen to the Japanese, and danger lurks in every shadow. This spy thriller delivers plenty of exotic glamor along with the tough guy bravado. Rated R.

**THE LOVE PUNCH (2013-France/UK/US)** 94m \*\* ½ D: Joel Hopkins. Emma Thompson, Pierce Brosnan, Celia Imrie, Timothy Spall, Louise Bourgoin, Laurent Lafitte. Divorced couple Richard (Brosnan) and Kate (Thompson) travel to Paris and Cannes in this delightfully wacky heist caper. Richard's company was purchased by a megacorp owned by rapacious CEO Kruger (Lafitte), who callously liquidated both Richard's and Kate's retirement funds. When they learn that Kruger is getting married, and the bride (Bourgoin) will be wearing a diamond the size of a golf ball, Richard and Kate hatch a bold plan. Nominated for 1 award. Rated PG-13.

**DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: A RAY OF LIGHT aka Una lama di luce (2013-Italy)** 107m \*\*\* ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Dajana Roncione, Angelo Russo. Detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) has two confounding mysteries to solve: A man claims his wife (Roncione) was assaulted and robbed of the cash she was carrying in her car—but not the expensive jewelry she was wearing. A farmer reports he can't get in his barn because someone installed a door and locked him out. For ages 14 and older.

**ZEN (2009-Japan)** 127m \*\*\* ½ D: Banmei Takahashi. Kankurō Nakamura, Yuki Uchida, Ryushin Tei, Kengo Kōra, Tianyong Zheng, Tatsuya Fujiwara. A young monk seeks the way to end human suffering in this serenely beautiful biopic on the life of Dogen (Nakamura), the 13th century monk and founder of Soto Zen Buddhism. After the death of his aristocratic mother, Dogen travels to China to learn the path to enlightenment through zazen (sitting meditation). When he returns to Japan to teach this new Buddhism, Dogen encounters fierce opposition from established monasteries. *The Japan Times* says, "The film offers an eloquent explanation of Dogen's Zen". For ages 12 and older.

**NODAME CANTABILE: THE MOVIE I (2009-Japan)** 122m \*\*\* D: Hideki Takeuchi. Juri Ueno, Hiroshi Tamaki, Yū Yamada. Piano student Megumi Noda aka NodaMe (Ueno) is talented but childlike—when she plays, she imagines rainbows, flowers and armies of cuddly teddy bears. Her boyfriend Chiaki (Tamaki) on the other hand, won first place in a competition and now heads his own (struggling) orchestra. The Japanese musical couple try to find their niche in Paris in this first part of two charming movies. Filmed in Japan and several European countries. For ages 12 and older.

**DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: A DELICATE MATTER aka Una Faccenda Delicata (2016-Italy)** 117m \*\*\* ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Sonia Bergamasco. Detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) is enjoying some time off with his girlfriend Livia (Bergamasco) in Bocca-dasse when he gets an exasperated phone call from inspector Fazio (Mazzotta) asking him to come back to Vigàta. A 67-year-old prostitute has been murdered, and Montalbano's deputy Mimi (Bocci) has a very contrived and kinky theory on how it happened in this amusing episode. For ages 14 and older.

**NODAME CANTABILE: THE MOVIE II (2010-Japan)** 123m \*\*\* D: Yasuhiro Kawamura, Hideki Takeuchi. Juri Ueno, Hiroshi Tamaki, Yū Yamada. Chiaki's growing fame and NodaMe's struggles to mature as an artist strain the couple's relationship. Yet self-doubt, jealousy and heartache can also enrich artistic expression. Favorite orchestral classics presented with verve frame the couple's romance in this film adaptation of the favorite manga. For ages 12 and up.

**STRAYED aka Les égarés (2003-France/UK)** 95m \*\*\* D: André Téchiné. Emmanuelle Béart, Gaspard Ulliel, Grégoire Leprince-Ringuet, Clémence Meyer. In June 1940 German troops are advancing on Paris. Widowed teacher Odile (Béart) flees the city by car with her children Philippe (Leprince-Ringuet) and Cathy (Meyer). While on the road German planes bomb the refugees, leaving Odile and her children with nothing. Helpless and naïve, Odile is rescued by 17-year-old delinquent Yvan (Ulliel) who finds shelter for the young family in this fascinating psychological thriller. Gaspard Ulliel won the Étoile d'Or for Best Male Newcomer for his role. For ages 15 and older.

**THE SEVENTH JUROR aka Le septième juré (1962-France)** 105m \*\*\* ½ D: Georges Lautner (THE PROFESSIONAL). Bernard Blier, Danièle Delorme, Jacques Riberolles, Albert Rémy, Maurice Biraud, Francis Blanche. In a moment of madness, respectable pharmacist Grégoire Duval (Blier) attacks a young woman sunbathing by the lake and kills her. Shocked with his own behavior, he flees from the scene of the crime. When playboy Sylvain Sautret (Riberolles) is arrested for the crime and Duval is chosen for the jury, Duval tries to redeem himself in this French film classic. For ages 12 and older.
