THE BROKENWOOD MYSTERIES: BROKENWOOD-O-SAURUS (2024-New Zealand) 97m *** D: Mike Smith. Neill Rea, Joanna Briant, Joseph Wycoff, Fern Sutherland, Karl Willetts, Kauri Williams. When homegrown paleontologist Maggie Sturridge (Briant) announces the discovery of dinosaur bones in Brokenwood, the whole town is abuzz with excitement. Their delight turns to dismay when American paleontologist Howard Wainwright (Wycoff) is found dead in a stream near the dig in this amusing episode. For ages 14 and older.

HEART OF OAK *aka Le Chêne* (2022-France) 81m *** ½ D: Laurent Charbonnier, Michel Seydoux. This enthralling film without dialogue chronicles 18 months in the life of a 210-year-old oak tree in Sologne, France. The tree supports a community of animals, from tiny acorn weevils to cheeky red squirrels to majestic deer. Their stories play out through remarkable nature photography that captures the daily drama of survival, the beauty of the forest, and the joys of new life. If you loved **MICROCOSMOS**, you will love this film. Nominated for Best Documentary at the César Awards. For all ages.

THE PROFESSOR AND HIS BELOVED EQUATION *aka Hakase no aishita sūshiki* (2006-Japan) 117m *** ½ D: Takashi Koizumi (AFTER THE RAIN). Akira Terao, Eri Fukatsu, Ruriko Asaoka, Hidetaka Yoshioka. Housekeeper Kyoko (Fukatsu) is hired by an icy widow (Asaoka) to care for her brother-in-law, a math professor (Terao). The kindly number theorist's memory is impaired due to a traffic accident—he can only remember 80 minutes' worth of new information. But his poetic way with numbers inspires Kyoko and her young son to love math in this beautiful and sensitive family drama. Winner of 2 awards. For ages 12 and older.

THE SECRET MISSION *aka Mal-Mo-E* (2019-South Korea) 135m *** D: Yu-na Eom (feature debut). Hae-Jin Yoo (LUCK-KEY), Kyesang Yoon, Hong-pa Kim, Hyeon Woo, Tae-hoon Kim, Sun-young Kim. In Japanese-occupied Korea in the 1940s, schools teach classes only in Japanese, and all citizens are forbidden to speak Korean. Illiterate petty thief Pan-soo (Yoo) unintentionally becomes involved in the secret publishing of a Korean dictionary in this funny and suspenseful drama. For ages 12 and older.

AUTUMN GOLD *aka Herbstgold* (2010-Germany/Austria) 94m *** ½ D: Jan Tenhaven. Five athletes train for the 2009 World Masters Championships in Finland: they seek to break world records. Jiri Soukup from the Czech Republic is the youngest at 82 years old. He's hoping to clear a high jump of 1 meter. Ilse Pleuger from Germany is a world-class shot putter at 85. Italian discus thrower Gabre Gabric won't tell you her age; she has a glamorous reputation to protect. She hopes to break 13 meters. Swedish sprinter Herbert Liedtke still has an eye for the ladies at 93, and the miraculous Alfred Proksch trains hard for Austria throwing the discus at 100—when he's not painting nude women in his studio. This doc was nominated for 2 awards. For ages 10 and older.

FOYLE'S WAR: BLEAK MIDWINTER (2007-UK) 93m *** ½ D: Gavin Millar. Michael Kitchen, Anthony Howell, Mali Harries, Honeysuckle Weeks. December 1942: Police sergeant Milner (Howell) is visited by his estranged wife Jane (Harries). She leaves after they argue, and, not long afterwards, is found dead on the street. When DCS Foyle (Kitchen) finds evidence that may link Milner to his wife's murder, he is forced to suspend him. Meanwhile, Sam (Weeks) drools over a plump turkey from a racketeering case that's locked in the evidence room. For ages 14 and older.

KILLING IS MY BUSINESS, HONEY *aka Mord ist mein Geschäft, Liebling* (2009-Germany) 104m *** D: Sebastian Niemann. Rick Kavanian, Nora Tschirner, Christian Tramitz, Janek Rieke, Franco Nero (DJANGO), Bud Spencer (THEY CALL ME TRINITY). In this hilarious comedy, insouciant Italian hitman Toni (Kavanian) falls for nerdy klutz Julia (Tschirner), who works for a Berlin publishing house. The problem is, she's trying to sign ex-mafioso-turned-writer Enrico Puzzo (a screamingly funny Franco Nero) while Toni's trying to kill him. This delightful screwball comedy is leavened with Dean Martin's nostalgic tunes. For ages 12 and older.

DETECTIVE MONTALBANO: PYRAMID OF MUD *aka La piramide di fango* (2016-Italy) 105m *** ½ D: Alberto Sironi. Luca Zingaretti, Cesare Bocci, Peppino Mazzotta, Teresa Mannino, Tony Laudadio. A man is found shot to death in a large pipe on a construction site in this complex mystery. Detective Montalbano (Zingaretti) learns that the deceased was an accountant for a construction firm involved in some shady business, but it's the dead man's German wife that provides clues to the case. For ages 14 and older.

DEATH ON THE NILE (1978-UK) 140m *** ½ D: Anthony Guillermin (TOWERING INFERNO). Peter Ustinov, Lois Chiles, Bette Davis, Mia Farrow, Angela Lansbury, Maggie Smith (12/28/1934-9/27/2024), David Niven, Jane Birkin, Jon Finch. The inimitable Peter Ustinov stars as Belgian sleuth Hercule Poirot in this glamorously produced Agatha Christie mystery. On a river boat plying Egypt's Nile River, young and beautiful Linnet (Chiles) is found shot to death in her bedchamber. Detective Poirot must find the killer among a boatful of suspects—each with a good reason to kill the arrogant heiress. It is a hoot to see Maggie Smith as a young woman—already lethal with the drop-dead one-liner. Winner of 5 awards, including an Oscar for (fabulous!) Costume Design. Rated PG.

WINTER'S FLOWER *aka Fuyu no hana* (1978-Japan) 121m *** D: Yasuo Furuhashi (DEAREST). Ken Takakura, Kimiko Ikegami, Kin'ya Kitaōji, Kunie Tanaka, Isao Natsuyagi, Susumu Fujita. Yakuza gangster Kanno (Takakura) kills a fellow gangster for betraying their boss (Fujita) and goes to prison for 15 years. What weighs on Kanno's mind isn't the slain man, but the slain man's daughter Yoko (Ikegami), who was three when her father died. Now a beautiful young woman, she wants more than anything to meet the kind man who's been supporting her for as long as she could remember. Takakura is terrific in this tale of a gangster's code of honor. For ages 12 and older.

THE HOLDOVERS (2023-US) 133m **** D: Alexander Payne (NEBRASKA). Paul Giamatti, Dominic Sessa, Da'Vine Joy Randolph. Carrie Preston, Brady Hepner, Michael Provost. The brilliant Paul Giamatti stars as grumpy, pedantic antiquities teacher Paul Hunham in this funny and touching comedy-drama set during the holiday season of 1970 New England. In trouble with the headmaster for failing the son of a senator, Paul is forced to stay on campus to babysit the “holdovers”—students who have nowhere to go for Christmas. He's left with one student, Angus (Sessa), who is disliked at school almost as much as Paul. Winner of 134 awards. Rated R.

DAREDEVIL IN THE CASTLE *aka Ōsaka-jō monogatari* (1961-Japan) 95m *** ½ D: Hiroshi Inagaki (SAMURAI TRILOGY). Toshiroh Mifune, Kyōko Kagawa, Isuzu Yamada, Takashi Shimura, Tetsurō Tanba, Yoshiko Kuga. Set 14 years after the Battle of Sekigahara, this swashbuckling tale concerns lovable ruffian Mohei (Mifune) who travels to Osaka looking for work. With tensions rising between the Tokugawa forces and Toyotomi rebels, Mohei is pressed into service for the Toyotomi cause by Lady Ai (Kagawa), whose mission is to prevent a war. Mohei lends his hell-raising skills at the Siege of Osaka Castle to win the damsel's heart. This colorful, grand samurai epic won a Kinema Junpo acting award for Mifune. Ages 12 and up.

SUMO DO, SUMO DON'T *aka Shiko Funjatta* (1992-Japan) 99m *** ½ D: Masayuki Suo (SHALL WE DANSU?). Masahiro Motoki, Naoto Takenaka. If he can graduate on time, Shuhei (Motoki) is guaranteed a good job—but his grades have been sliding. His professor has promised he'll graduate on one condition: Shuhei must join the sumo team. It turns out the “team” has only one other member, the pathetic Aoki (Takenaka). The two draft a bunch of misfits who blossom into sumo enthusiasts in this hilarious winner of 24 film awards. For all ages.

THE VANISHING OF PATO *aka La scomparsa di Patò* (2010-Italy) 98m *** D: Rocco Mortelliti. Maurizio Casagrande, Nino Frassica, Alessandra Mortelliti, Neri Marcorè, Giacinto Ferro. This delightful mystery written by the creator of **DETECTIVE MONTALBANO**, Andrea Camilleri, takes us back in time to Easter weekend, 1890 in the fictional Sicilian town of Vigàta. When hardworking family man Patò (Marcorè) disappears after performing in the annual passion play, Ernesto (Casagrande) of the polizia and Paolo (Frassica) of the carabinieri squabble to take the case. The two police officers are forced to work together in this funny, satirical award-nominated film. For ages 12 and older.

DRIVING MADELEINE *aka Une belle course* (2022-France/ Belgium) 91m *** ½ D: Christian Carion (THE GIRL FROM PARIS). Line Renaud, Dany Boon, Alice Isaaz. Taxi driver Charles (Boon) is having a rough time: he's in debt and he's worried about losing his license. Little does he know that his next fare will change his life. When he picks up 92-year-old Madeleine (Renaud) in a Paris suburb, she tells him there will be stops along the way. She's in no hurry to get to the retirement home. As the ride progresses, Charles learns of the adventurous life this immaculately groomed Parisienne lives in this touching drama. Winner of 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

PELICAN MAN *aka Pelikaanimies* (2004-Finland) 84m *** ½ D: Liisa Helminen. Kari Ketonen, Roni Haarakangas, Inka Nuorgam, Jonna Järnefelt, Anu Viheriäranta. Young Emil (Haarakangas) discovers that a mysterious new visitor in town (Ketonen) is a pelican in disguise. Opera-loving “Mr. Berd” wants to learn the ways of humans, partly because he's fallen in love with bird-like ballerina Helena (Viheriäranta). This lovely bit of Finnish whimsy won 7 awards. For children of all ages.

TSCHUGGER Part 1 of 2 (2021-Switzerland) 155m *** D: David Constantin, Mats Frey. David Constantin, Dragan Vujic, Anna-Lena Miano, Arsène Junior Page, Cedric Schild, Anna Rossinelli. In the Swiss canton of Valais or Wallis, “tschugger” means cop. Although his precinct is mostly worried about livestock theft, tschugger Bax (Constantin) dreams of making drug busts like they do in Hollywood movies. After spending months tailing small-time marijuana dealer Valmira (Miano), Bax sends clueless trainee Smetterling, aka “Butterfly” (Schild) undercover in a daring operation... which goes hilariously wrong. This fabulously entertaining and well-scripted miniseries won 1 award. For ages 12 and older.

TSCHUGGER Part 2 of 2 (2022-Switzerland) 150m *** ½ D: David Constantin, Mats Frey. David Constantin, Dragan Vujic, Anna-Lena Miano, Arsène Junior Page, Cedric Schild, Anna Rossinelli. When Valmira's (Miano) pothead flunky Juni (Page) finds a mysterious key—he takes it to the police and is laughed out of the station. But Juni is actually onto something—a sinister cult gathers at the Christ Roi statue high above the valley, and they plan to use the key to endanger the Valais! Bax (Constantin) would love to be the hero but he's on the run from his own precinct. Will Bax's nerdy partner Pirmin (Vujic) stand up to the challenge? This second part is even better than the first! For ages 15 and older.
